WITNESS STATEMENT OF JULIE AMANDA ROWE

I, Julie Amanda Rowe, Trainee Solicitor, of 22 Upper Brighton Road, Surbiton, Surrey, KT6 6LS, say as follows:

1. I attended the part-time Graduate Diploma in Law course at Kingston University, Kingston Hill, between September 2003 and July 2005.
2. During this period I became acquainted with the Claimant. We attended the same tutorials and lectures throughout the entire course.

3. We often used to chat with each other prior to the start of lectures which began at 6.15pm on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings.

4. I can recall that on one evening at the university, shortly after the start of the Autumn Term of our second year, the Claimant and I had a conversation about his father.

5. I remember that the Claimant expressed concern about his father's health. He told me that he had been to visit his father in Hersham that day and had been shocked at his father's appearance. I distinctly recall that he mentioned his father looking 'pregnant' with his illness. This stuck in my mind as it is an unusual term to describe a man.

6. I believe that the facts stated in this witness statement are true.
