In the estate of Graham Sheppard deceased


I Margaret Ann Bacon of 57 Cedars Road Exeter EX2 4NB make oath and say that:

1. On a Tuesday, I regularly visit Tom and Ruth Barling and have done so for many years. I stay morning and afternoon.
2. On a Tuesday in 2004, either Tom or Ruth told me that Graham and Margaret Sheppard, their son-in-law and daughter, were coming that day so that Tom and Ruth could witness Graham's signature on his Will.
3. I remember it being 2004 because Graham and Margaret were married earlier that year. I thought when told of a Will to be signed that Graham was making a Will after the marriage as so often is done. I also remember this occasion because I have not been present on such an occasion before or since and therefore could not confuse it with any similar happening.
4. Graham and Margaret duly came and I offered to leave but was asked to stay and I went into the lounge area. The dining and lounge areas are half open plan, half glazed doors. The others stayed grouped around the dining table. I heard the voices of the four people concerned and the signing was completed in about five minutes. A straightforward business quickly done.
5. From all I have seen of Graham – at other times and on this day – he appeared in full control of the business, master minded it and was the guiding force in the partnership and marriage.
