
I Richard James Sheppard of The Livingstone Adventure Centre, Musi O Tunya Road, Livingstone, Zambia, the brother of the Claimant, will say as follows:

1. It is my recollection that shortly after my father (the Deceased) passed away, which was on 24 August 2005, the Claimant picked me up from Heathrow Airport and we returned to Teignmouth to stay with the First Defendant. It was during this short stay that the First Defendant produced copies of both my father's 2004 and 2005 Wills.
2. The First Defendant stated that the 2005 Will was invalid and that by rights we should revert to the 2004 Will.
3. The First Defendant said that the Claimant and I would be left significantly reduced legacies under the 2004 Will, as we could see from the copy of it.
4. The First Defendant then stated that there was an earlier Will, from 2002, which left the Claimant and me even less, but which was definitely valid.
5. Subsequently the First Defendant has failed on several occasions to confirm to me her intentions with respect to the property known as Hunters Way, Inkpen.
6. I would like it noted that I have supplied this statement to provide the facts and have no intention nor interest in a claim on the property or any other assets.

I believe that the facts in this statement are true.
